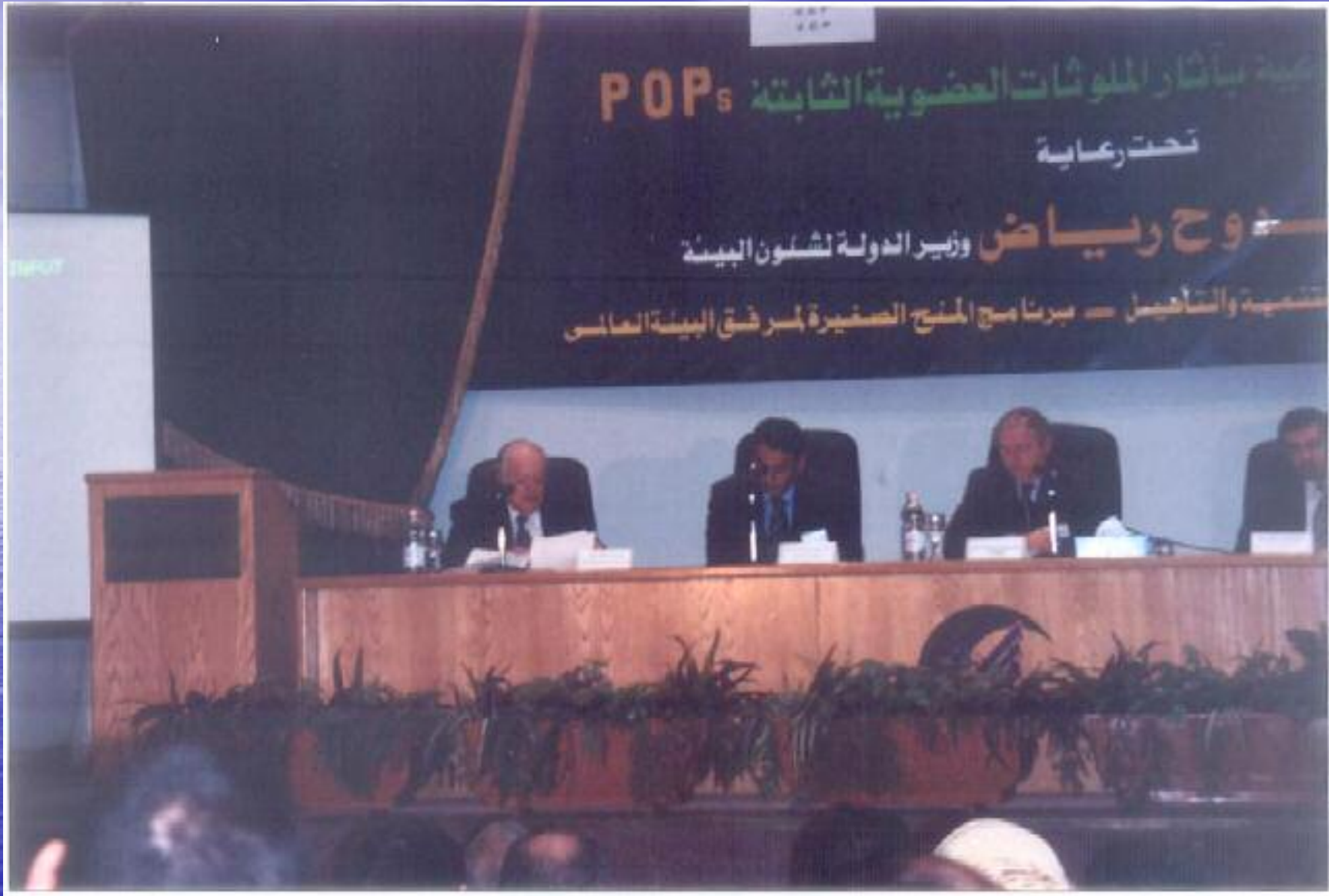

- Enhance NGOs skills and knowledge to help build their capabilities as effective stakeholders in the Convention implementation process .
- Help establish regional and national NGOs coordination in different regions of the world in order to achieve chemical safety on the long run .

# Project Activities

- IPEP will support NGOs in 40 countries including east Europe countries to prepare substantial reports on persistent organic pollutants . These reports will be available on the internet websites in several languages for global use .
- The reports will include, country situation report , policy brief reports and hot-spot reports about POPs.
