What is The SEC?

- A Ministerial committee guiding and overseeing the energy sector in Egypt
- Established in 1979 under Prime Ministerial decree No. 1093, and reformed in 2006 with decree No. 1395
- 11 Ministries on the Council headed by the PM
 - *Defense, Finance, Petroleum, Electricity, Economic Development, Environment, Investment, Housing, Trade & Industry, Transport, and Foreign Affairs*



What Does the SEC Do?

- Developing energy strategies in support of Egypt's economic and social development policies as well as efficiency objectives. Such strategies cover availability of energy resources, production and consumption patterns.
- A 'Technical Secretariat' provides technical and coordination support



Program Description

- Policy and technical assistance to the ‘Secretariat’ in the Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy areas
- A main consulting unit supported by external resources to provide:
 - *Suggestions for specific market or policy initiatives*
 - *Position papers on key relevant topics*
 - *Impact studies of SEC decisions*
 - *Other support as needed*



Technical Assistance Activities

- Collecting and reviewing relevant information
- Drafting policy and position papers on priority topics

renewable energy

restructuring

- Providing coordination assistance among relevant ministries (either prior to discussion at SEC meetings, or as a result of SEC decisions)



Target Results

- **Decisions / Decrees** -- issued by the SEC leading to increasing EE or expediting RE development
- **Market Barriers** removed -- (Examples: subsidy reform, creation of financing vehicles, etc)
- **Market Initiatives** introduced -- (Examples: EE in Government buildings, manufacturing of equipment locally, etc)
