The Ministry of Environment “EEAA” *has received* financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Greater Cairo Air Pollution Management and Climate Change Project “GCCC”, The Ministry of Environment, an implementing agency of the Client, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this loan to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Proposals is issued. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank’s Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.
2. The Greater Cairo Air Pollution Management and Climate Change Project “GCCC” now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the supply of Short-Lived Climate pollutants (SLCP), Green House Gases (GHG), PM<sub>x</sub> monitoring equipment and air sampling filters to upgrade the current EEAA ambient air quality monitoring network in Greater Cairo as follows:
  - Lot 1:** Black Carbon absorption photometer or equivalent aerosol absorption monitor
  - Lot 2:** PM<sub>x</sub> (PM<sub>2.5</sub>/PM<sub>10</sub>) Monitors, Meteorological Stations
  - Lot 3:** Data Loggers
  - Lot 4:** High Precision Greenhouse Gas Monitor
  - Lot 5:** Various Types of Particulate Matter Sampling Filters

**The bidders are allowed to quote separate prices for one or more lots.**

3. Bidding will be conducted through International competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "[Procurement](#) Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 revised November 2017 & August 2018 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. ("Procurement Regulations") and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Greater Cairo Air Pollution Management and Climate Change Project, and inspect the bidding document during office hours from 9:00 to 17:00 the address given below.
5. The Bidding document in English language may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a **written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of USD 300 or equivalent in EGP**. The method of payment will be in Bank transfer in the Bank account of the Egyptian Central Bank – The Environmental Protection Fund (EPF). The document will be sent by airmail for overseas delivery by courier services and may be required for overseas delivery against courier charge.

The outer Bid envelopes marked "ORIGINAL BID", and the inner envelopes marked "TECHNICAL PART" will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below ***October 7<sup>th</sup> 2024, at 13:00 CLT***. All envelopes marked "SECOND ENVELOPE: FINANCIAL PART" shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Purchaser until the second public opening.
