White Desert Protected Area

The White Desert Protected Area extends over 3010 km² of astonishing scenery. Limestone stacks create a spectacular landscape that has made the White Desert world famous. Relic oasis habitats contain the largest concentrations of natural vegetation remaining in the Western Desert. Fascinating cultural heritage sites dating from prehistoric times to the recent past dot the area and the park's Saharan fauna and flora represent rare and highly endangered biodiversity.

Farafra Oasis

Closer to Libya than to the Nile Valley, this small peaceful oasis was an important trade route in the Middle Ages because of its strategic position. The local people have their own dialect as they are of Bedouin ancestry, with Libyan and Tunisian origins. Palm, apricot and olive plantations are widely cultivated and although these 'gardens' are privately owned, no doors exclude visitors who are welcomed by the friendly farmers. You can also visit Qasr El Farafra, the old town overlooking the oases or enjoy the hot spring of Bir Sitta that serves as a natural lacuzzi.

White Chalk Formations

The White Desert beckons with its vast horizons outlining free standing stacks, all carved by the elements from pure white chalk. These rock formations each carry a unique posture and aura resembling familiar images. One can perceive a giant eagle, a weeping lady, a sphinx, a camel, and even a huge whale. The most iconic of these are the giant mushrooms, which unfortunately are the last forms a chalk structure takes before the forces of erosion cause it to topple.

To maintain a well-managed, representative system of parks conserving natural resources, contributing to sustainable economic growth and providing education, inspiration and enjoyment for all.
